

Information Obligations under the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

1. Name and contact details of the Data Controller and of the company's Data Protection Officer

2. Scope, type and purpose of the collection of personal data

We process personal data which we receive from you within the scope of the business relationship.
Relevant personal data are:

- Salutation, first name, surname, telephone number (landline and/or mobile), email address, as well as your communication with us:
These data are collected,
- for correspondence purposes;
- to substantiate and fulfil any contractual obligations arising from contractual agreements within the framework of purchase and supply contracts as well as service contracts (details on this can be found in the respective contract documents and GTC);
- This data is collected for correspondence purposes and to protect our legitimate interests or those of third parties (e.g. assertion of legal claims and defence in legal disputes, measures for business management and further development of services and products).

We have a legitimate interest in the processing of your data (Art. 6 Paragraph 1 Sentence 1 lit. f GDPR), as otherwise we cannot fulfil our contractual obligations promptly and properly and the enforcement of our legal positions cannot be pursued. Business optimisation is also only possible in this way.

3. Source of personal data

We process personal data which we receive from you within the scope of the business relationship.

4. Disclosure of data ("Recipients" or "Categories of Recipients")

In principle, recipients of your personal data within ROTORCOMP or the companies affiliated with ROTORCOMP (pursuant to Sections 15 et seq. of the German Stock Corporation Act (AktG)) are only those persons whose knowledge is required for the purpose for which the data is processed. Any passing on to third parties takes place under observance of the valid data protection regulations exclusively, if legal regulations require this, if this is necessary for the fulfilment of contractual obligations, if you have consented or if we are authorised to issue information. Under these conditions, Recipients of personal data may be, for example, public bodies and institutions (e.g. public offices) if there is a legal or official obligation. The data provided may be processed by the Recipients exclusively for the purposes mentioned above. Processing for any other purpose is not permitted.

5. Storage period

The personal data collected by us for this purpose will be stored until the end of the legal storage obligation (e.g. from the German Commercial Code (HGB), the German Penal Code (StGB) or German Taxation Regulation (AO)) and then deleted, unless you have consented to a longer storage (Art. 6 Paragraph 1 Sentence 1 lit. a GDPR).

6. Rights of Data Subjects

You have the right:

- to **revoke your consent** to us at any time, with the consequence that we may no longer continue the data processing based on this consent for the future (Art. 7 Paragraph 3 GDPR);
- to request **information** about your personal data processed by us (Art. 15 GDPR). In particular, you may request information about the processing purposes, the type of personal data, the recipients of your data, the planned storage period, the origin of your data if it has not been collected from us, and about the existence of automated decision-making including profiling and, if applicable, meaningful information about its details;
- to request the **correction** of incorrect or incomplete personal data stored by us (Art. 16 GDPR);
- to demand **deletion** of your personal data stored with us, as far as the processing is not necessary for the fulfilment of a legal obligation, for reasons of the public interest or for the assertion, practice or defence of legal claims on our side (Art. 17 GDPR);
- to **restrict** the processing of your personal data if the accuracy of the data is disputed by you or the processing is unlawful (Art. 18 GDPR);
- to receive your personal data that you have provided to us in a machine-readable format or to request transmission to another responsible person (**Right to Data Portability**, Art. 20 GDPR), and
- to complain to a supervisory authority (Art. 77 GDPR). In our case, this is: Bayerisches Landesamt für Datenschutzaufsicht (Bavarian State Office for Data Protection Supervision), Promenade 18, 91522 Ansbach.

7. Right of Objection

You have the right to object to the processing of your personal data at any time for reasons related to your particular situation.

If you file an objection, we will no longer process your personal data unless we can prove compelling reasons for processing worthy of protection which outweigh your interests, rights and freedoms or the processing serves the assertion, exercise or defence of legal claims.
